Admissions Information

General Information

Admission to the School of Missionary Aviation Technology is open to all students who have the proper background and capacity to benefit from the program and courses taught in the FAA Airframe and Powerplant curriculum.

The School of Missionary Aviation Technology is committed to training persons in aviation mechanics for the purpose of equipping them for Christian Service in Missionary Aviation. However, entrance into the program is open to all persons, regardless of their religious affiliation. There are certain standards of conduct to which we ask all students to ascribe. These are:

- a) To respect and honorably adhere to the standards of conduct of the school.
- b) To be discerning in the areas of media and entertainment
- c) To abstain from illegal drugs and excessive use of alcohol.
- d) To avoid immoral behavior in such areas as sexual behavior, lying, stealing and cheating.

Admission Fees & Costs

- a) Submit this admissions application to the School of Missionary Aviation Technology, 468 E Sprague Rd D-175, Ionia, MI 48846
- b) Include with the application, a \$25 application fee. An additional \$500 registration fee will be required once you have been accepted into the program. This registration fee will be applied to the total tuition when enrolling in the course of study being pursued.

Application Deadline

- a) Applicants should register as soon as possible for the semester they plan to attend.
- b) Applications will be considered and processed until the first day of class unless class is filled. After that time, entrance into the program will be based on the Program Administrators recommendation.

Missions or Non-Missions Student

Since the School of Missionary Aviation Technology exists to train missionary aviation pilots and mechanics, certain privileges and responsibilities are accorded to students who are considering preparation for the mission field. These students will need to have the Letter of Recommendation completed by their Pastor, Youth Pastor or Missions Representative to be classified as a Missions Student.

Further information regarding this classification can be obtained from the College Catalog or Student Handbook.

Financial Aid

Students may qualify for grants, loans and scholarships through an affiliation with colleges that may accept SMAT course completions as elective credit. Contact the Financial Aid office of the college through which you will be applying.

Arrangements may be made with students for payment throughout the semester on an individual basis. However, a student may be asked to withdraw from classes if a delinquency in payment persists.

Withdrawal/Refund Policy

The tuition and fees paid by the applicant shall be refunded if the applicant is rejected by the school before enrollment. An application fee of not more than \$25.00 may be retained by the school if the application is denied. All tuition and fees paid by the applicant shall be refunded if requested within 3 business days after signing a contract with the school. All refunds will be returned within 30 days. Once the 3 business days have elapsed the following policies will apply.

Full refund: *If less than 5 days into the module (less registration fee)*

50% tuition refund: *If more than 5 days but less than 30 calendar days from module start (less total lab fee)*

No refund: *If more than 30 calendar days from module start*
